



<u>GCT Canada Future of Nations Scholarship for Indigenous Students</u> <u>Tsawwassen First Nation 2023</u>

About: The GCT Canada Future of Nations Scholarship for Indigenous Students will award one (1) scholarship annually worth \$2,500.00 to a Tsawwassen First Nation Member student who demonstrates strong academic performance, community involvement, and leadership. GCT Canada introduced its first annual Scholarship with TFN in 2022.

Deadline: The 2023 scholarship launched on March 17, 2023. Applications must be submitted by 5:00PM on August 7, 2023.

Eligibility:

- Tsawwassen First Nation Member
- Permanent resident or citizen of Canada
- Applied to or are currently enrolled in an accredited post-secondary institution (ITA training program, trades or technical school, college, or university)
- Maintain a full course load that leads to a recognized degree, certificate, designation, or diploma
- Shows strong potential to successfully complete the post-secondary program
- Has not received a scholarship from GCT Canada in the past two years
- All programs and pursuits of study are eligible and applications from all are encouraged; preference may be given to those pursuing programs with potential to lead to a career in transportation/trade/logistics or maritime sector, if applicable

Requirements: Ensure the following documents are included with your application submission.

- Completed application form (as enclosed)
- Two letters of recommendation
- Official transcript of grades (high school and/or most recently available post-secondary)
- Resume, including volunteer experience
